

Dua After Wudu

Arabic, English Translation, Transliteration & Hadith

The dua after Wudu is a Sunnah remembrance recited after completing ablution. The best-established supplication begins with the Shahadah, and authentic narrations also mention additional words of remembrance.

The Shahadah (Primary Dua After Wudu)

أشهد أن لا إله إلا الله وحده لا شريك له، وأشهد أن محمدا عبده ورسوله

Transliteration:

Ashhadu an la ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lahu, wa ashhadu anna Muhammadan' abduhu wa rasuluhu.

English Translation:

I bear witness that there is no deity worthy of worship except Allah alone, with no partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger.

This is the primary dua to say after Wudu and is authentically reported from Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him).

The Eight Gates of Jannah – Hadith

The virtue of reciting the Shahadah after Wudu is mentioned in Sahih Muslim. Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) taught that whoever performs Wudu properly and then recites the testimony of faith, the eight gates of Paradise are opened for them, and they may enter through whichever gate they wish.

Allahummaj'alni Minat-Tawwabin

اللهم اجعلني من التوابين واجعلني من المتطهرين

Transliteration:

Allahummaj'alni minat-tawwabina waj'alni minal-mutatahhirin.

English Translation:

O Allah, make me among those who constantly repent and make me among those who purify themselves.

Full Dua After Wudu (Combined)

له، وأشهد أن محمدا عبده ورسوله، اللهم اجعلني من التوابين واجعلني من المتطهرين
أشهد أن لا إله إلا الله وحده لا شريك

Transliteration:

Ashhadu an la ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lahu, wa ashhadu anna Muhammadan' abduhu wa rasuluhu. Allahummaj'alni minat-tawwabina waj'alni minal-mutatahhirin.

English Translation:

I bear witness that there is no deity worthy of worship except Allah alone, with no partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger. O Allah, make me among those who constantly repent and make me among those who purify themselves.

Subhanakallahumma Dua After Wudu

سبحانك اللهم وبحمدك، أشهد أن لا إله إلا أنت، أستغفرك وأتوب إليك

Transliteration:

Subhanakallahumma wa bihamdika, ashhadu an la ilaha illa anta, astaghfiruka wa atubu ilayk.

English Translation:

Glory and praise be to You, O Allah. I bear witness that there is no deity worthy of worship except You. I seek Your forgiveness and repent to You.

Dua Before Wudu

بسم الله

Transliteration:

Bismillah.

English Translation:

In the name of Allah.

Is It Compulsory?

No, the dua after Wudu is not compulsory, and leaving it does not invalidate Wudu. The remembrance is recommended after completing ablution, so a person's Wudu remains valid even if they forget or do not recite it.
