

# Authentic Duas for Entering & Leaving the Masjid

## 1. Dua for Entering the Masjid

اللَّهُمَّ افْتَحْ لِي أَبْوَابَ رَحْمَتِكَ

**Transliteration:** Allahumma iftah li abwaba rahmatik.

**English Meaning:** O Allah, open for me the doors of Your mercy.

## 2. Seeking Allah's Protection When Entering

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ، وَبِوَجْهِهِ الْكَرِيمِ، وَسُلْطَانِهِ الْقَدِيمِ، مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

**Transliteration:** A'udhu billahil-'Azim, wa bi-wajhihil-karim, wa sultanihil-qadim, minash-shaytanir-rajim.

**English Meaning:** I seek refuge in Allah the Magnificent, in His Noble Face and His eternal authority, from the accursed Satan.

## 3. Dua for Leaving the Masjid

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ

**Transliteration:** Allahumma inni as'aluka min fadlik.

**English Meaning:** O Allah, I ask You from Your bounty.

## 4. Longer Dua When Leaving the Masjid

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ، اللَّهُمَّ  
اغْصِنِي مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

**Transliteration:** Bismillah, was-salamu 'ala Rasulillah. Allahumma inni as'aluka min fadlik.  
Allahumma'simni minash-shaytanir-rajim.

**English Meaning:** In the name of Allah, and peace be upon the Messenger of Allah. O Allah, I ask You from Your bounty. O Allah, protect me from the accursed Satan.

## 5. Dua for Going to the Masjid

اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْ فِي قَلْبِي نُورًا، وَفِي لِسَانِي نُورًا، وَاجْعَلْ فِي سَمْعِي نُورًا، وَاجْعَلْ  
فِي بَصَرِي نُورًا، وَاجْعَلْ مِنْ خَلْفِي نُورًا، وَمِنْ أَمَامِي نُورًا، وَاجْعَلْ مِنْ فَوْقِي  
نُورًا، وَمِنْ تَحْتِي نُورًا، اللَّهُمَّ أَعْطِنِي نُورًا

**Transliteration:** Allahummaj'al fi qalbi nuran, wa fi lisani nuran, waj'al fi sam'i nuran, waj'al fi basari  
nuran, waj'al min khalfi nuran, wa min amami nuran, waj'al min fawqi nuran, wa min tahti nuran.  
Allahumma a'tini nuran.

**English Meaning:** O Allah, place light in my heart, light on my tongue, light in my hearing and light in  
my sight. Place light behind me, before me, above me and beneath me. O Allah, grant me light.
